CODE OF ETHICS

As members of the N.W.M.P.C.A., we share the responsibility for maintaining and protecting its interests and image, and the image of its members. Therefore, we agree that:

a: we join the N.W.M.P.C.A. to benefit the Association and to bring something of it and ourselves to the public. We do not join the Association for monetary benefit, or to derive personal gain at the expense of the Association, and

b: the North-West Mounted Police were para-military. To commemorate them, we will strive to maintain a healthy esprit de corps, promote the Association through service and respect, and maintain a high standard of dress, deportment and discipline while in uniform, so as to bring credit to the Association and its members.

GENERAL RULES OF CONDUCT

Delegated Authority:

When a member (<u>regardless of rank</u>) has been delegated as the member in charge of a patrol, or any other activity, it is paramount that he or she, while in that position of authority, be respected. The member in charge will be held responsible for the overall organization of the patrol/activity as far as the Association is concerned. All members accompanying him or her will be expected to give their full co-operation.

Public Appearances:

No member(s) shall appear in uniform or in costume without prior approval by a majority of the Board of Directors or by a majority of the members, in good standing, at an Association meeting. Interaction with the public or media on a patrol is to be encouraged, with the following exception:

Media Releases:

ANY OFFICIAL RELEASES of Association business to the public or media must be cleared by the Board of Directors.

General Rules For Public Appearances (e.g., Parades):

- Uniformed members will maintain proper military deportment.
- Uniform and kit will be clean, polished and presentable.
- Members will respect and properly care for mounts.
- Costumed members will display a clean appearance and maintain proper deportment
- All items that are the property of the N.W.M.P.C.A., whether on individual loan or for general use by the members must be properly cared for and protected against loss, damage and abuse.

All items of kit provided to me by the N.W.M.P.C.A. remain the property of the Association and must be signed for when issued and returned within 30 days if, for any reason, I cease to be a member of the Association.
